KCC Interactive 'Smarter play' app

KCC's Smarter-Play app – Is a new innovative way for parents to receive regular pop-ups every week sharing ideas on how you can be more involved with your children's learning at home. It has useful geo-location features such as local settings, schools, parks, zoos, children's centers. It has a 'special moments' section allowing you to record key learning and special times with your child using text, video and photos. You can read in depth information and access useful links on key issues around child development to include areas such as the importance of attachment, physical play, and sensory play for example, and an interactive quiz.
