


# Advice to Parents & Professionals for Remote Learning & Live Streaming



If you have been offered the opportunity for your child to participate in an online service such as Speech and Language Therapy, 1:1 tuition etc, please ensure your child's online safety by taking the following measures:

- ❖ Make sure that the email address you are connecting to is a work related one and not the personal email address of the professional.
- ❖ Always ensure you have liaised with school before tuition commences.
- ❖ All remote learning should take place during school hours.
- ❖ Your child should be supervised by an appropriate adult at all times.
- ❖ Ensure that the platform being used to deliver the remote learning is a safe and known app/system e.g. Zoom.
- ❖ Consider the location you and your child joins from and what can be seen and heard on screen.
